- 3. Purpose of activity: The primary purpose of the workshop conducted at Kishorbhai Institute of Agriculture Sciences and Research Centre, sponsored by ICAR-Directorate of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants Research, Boriavi, Anand, Gujarat, was to advance the knowledge and skills of students, researchers, farmers and agricultural professionals in the field of medicinal and aromatic plant research, cultivation and related businesses. The workshop aimed to provide participants with a deeper understanding of the potential of these plants, focusing on their sustainable cultivation, processing, and utilization for both medicinal and commercial purposes.

Through expert-led sessions and discussions, the workshop covered key topics such as the latest research in medicinal and aromatic plant species, innovative farming practices, quality control methods, and the economic benefits of integrating these plants into agro-ecosystems.

The workshop sought to create a platform for collaboration between academic institutions, research bodies, farmers and industry stakeholders to exchange ideas and share best practices. By aligning with ICAR-Directorate of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants Research's mission, the workshop contributed to the promotion of sustainable agriculture practices and the enhancement of the medicinal and aromatic plant sector in India.

4. Activity details: The one-day workshop, jointly organized by Medi-Hub Technology Business Incubator, Kishorbhai Institute of Agriculture Sciences and Research Centre, Uka Tarsadia University, Bardoli, and ICAR-Directorate of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants Research (DMAPR), Anand, Gujarat, was a significant initiative aimed at

fostering knowledge and innovation in agriculture. Sponsored by ICAR-DMAPR, the event brought together students, progressive farmers, and faculty members, emphasizing agribusiness opportunities and technological advancements in agriculture. The workshop commenced with the distribution of welcome kits at 8:30 AM, followed by an inaugural session at 9:30 AM. The program began with a traditional lamp-lighting ceremony, UTU anthem and ICAR anthem. Dr. R. Nagaraja Reddy, Senior Scientist & founder of Medi-Hub, TBI, ICAR-DMAPR, Anand, delivered a welcome address, setting a collaborative and motivational tone for the event. Mr. Devang Kadiwala, founder of M/s. Suhavya, Surat, presented an inspiring session on his agritech startup journey, discussing innovative solutions like precision agriculture, vertical farming, and agritech education.

Key dignitaries, including Dr. D. R. Shah (CEO, UTU), Dr. R. Nagaraja Reddy, Mr. Devang Kadiwala and Dr. Snehalkumar Patel (Business Manager, Medi-Hub, TBI) were formally introduced and welcomed by Dr. R. Krishnamurthy, Director of Kishorbhai Institute of Agriculture Sciences. This was followed by a tea break, where participants networked and exchanged ideas.

The technical sessions featured discussions on agribusiness opportunities, with Dr. R. Nagaraja Reddy leading an interactive session on Agristart-ups: Overview and Opportunities. In his session, he gave some examples such as saffron and coriander cultivation. A special segment by a farmer-cum-businessman, Mr. Zoheir Lokhandwala, highlighted the practical application of organic solutions for nutrient and pest management, inspiring participants with his success story.

Dr. Snehalkumar Patel elaborated on the role of Medi-Hub, TBI, in fostering agribusiness development, offering insights on startup ecosystems, policies, incentives, and mentorship.

Post-lunch, Dr. R. Krishnamurthy delved into business opportunities in medicinal plants, citing examples like Brahmi, Ashwagandha, and Shatavari, while Dr. Snehalkumar Patel shared actionable steps for transforming ideas into successful agribusiness ventures.

The workshop concluded with a valedictory session addressed by Dr. R. Krishnamurthy followed by a vote of thanks from Dr. R. Nagaraja Reddy. The national anthem marked the formal closure of the event, which ended on a high note with high tea and memorable group photographs, cementing the workshop's success as a platform for agricultural innovation and entrepreneurship.

5. Outcome achieved:

Quantitative Outcomes:

a. Participation:

- Students: 102 students (48 Female + 54 Male) from different departments have actively participated.
- o Farmers: 22 progressive farmers participated in the workshop.
- o Faculty Members: 19 faculty members
- o External Guests: 8 distinguished speakers and guests

b. Sessions Conducted:

 2 technical sessions covering agritech startups, business development, and medicinal plants.

c. Resource Distribution:

o 122 welcome kits were distributed to participants.

o 5 organic products provided by a farmer-cum-businessman to attendees.

d. Networking:

 Multiple networking opportunities facilitated between participants, industry leaders, farmers and faculty members.

Qualitative Outcomes:

a. Knowledge Enhancement:

 Participants gained insights into agritech innovations, startup ecosystems, and medicinal plant business opportunities.

 Farmers and students learned about emerging trends in agriculture, including precision farming and organic solutions.

b. Skill Development:

 Students were introduced to practical applications of agribusiness and startup management.

 Farmers acquired strategies for implementing sustainable and innovative agricultural practices.

c. Motivation and Inspiration:

 Personal success stories, such as those shared by Mr. Devang Kadiwala and farmer-entrepreneur Zoheir, inspired participants to explore agribusiness ventures.

o Encouragement from experts boosted confidence among students to pursue careers in agritech and related fields.

d. Collaborative Engagement:

The workshop fostered connections between academia, industry, and the farming community, creating opportunities for future collaborations.

Active Q&A sessions strengthened the interaction between experts, students, and farmers.

e. Awareness and Policy Understanding:

 Participants were made aware of government policies, incentives, and support systems for agribusiness startups.

 The session on ecosystems for startups helped attendees understand practical approaches to scaling their ideas.

6. Feedback and Reflections:

Student Feedback:

a. Engagement and Learning:

 Students appreciated the interactive sessions, particularly the opportunity to ask questions directly to industry and research experts.

 The practical examples and success stories shared during the workshop were highly motivational and relatable. b. Relevance of Topics:

 Many participants mentioned that the sessions on agritech startups and medicinal plant business opportunities provided valuable insights into emerging trends and career prospects.

Students felt that the workshop effectively bridged theoretical knowledge with

practical applications in agriculture.

c. Organization and Resources:

 The distribution of welcome kits and well-structured schedule were highlighted as positive aspects.

o Networking sessions, including tea breaks and lunch, allowed students to

connect with professionals and peers.

d. Suggestions:

 Some students suggested increasing the duration of individual technical sessions to allow more in-depth discussion.

Reflections from Organizers:

a. Success Factors:

o The collaboration with ICAR-DMAPR added credibility and expertise, ensuring high-quality content and diverse perspectives.

The choice of speakers, combining industry, academic, and entrepreneurial

insights, resonated well with the audience.

b. Challenges Faced:

o Managing time for each session was challenging due to the enthusiastic participation and extended Q&A sessions.

 Ensuring seamless transportation for all participants required careful coordination.

c. Potential Improvements:

o Including more hands-on or field-based activities could further enhance the experiential learning aspect.

 Future workshops might incorporate breakout sessions for smaller, focused group discussions.

d. Overall Reflection:

 The workshop achieved its primary objectives of knowledge dissemination, skill development, and fostering connections between students, farmers, and experts.

The positive feedback and high engagement levels indicate the effectiveness of

the workshop's design and execution.
