5. **Creative Clay Models:** The Clay Modelling competition featured diverse and imaginative creations, highlighting students' hands-on skills.

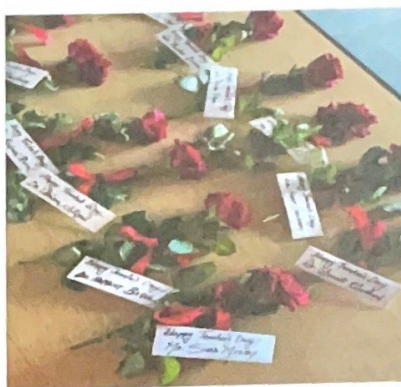
6. **Sustainable Projects:** The Best Out of Waste competition encouraged students to transform recycled materials into creative and functional items.
