To celebrate Teacher's Day Month by giving back to the community and spreading the importance of education, our NSS students decided to visit Goji Village and distribute stationery kits to the students of AshramShala who need proper education materials. Before the event, a planning committee was formed consisting of NSS student volunteers, faculty advisors, and coordinators. The committee worked diligently to organize the logistics and gather the necessary stationery items. NSS students and faculty members collected stationery items such as notebooks, pencils, erasers, sharpeners, crayon colors, and geometry sets. The collection was done through donations from fellow students and fundraising efforts. On September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023, a group of 40 NSS students along with faculty members and coordinators embarked on a trip to Goji Village. The village was selected because of its remote location and the presence of Asharamshala, where many underprivileged children reside. At the Asharamshala, our NSS students interacted with the students from standards 1 to 8, who are staying away from home due to their pursuit of education. More than 170 students were provided with a stationery kit, which was distributed personally by our students.

In addition to distributing stationery, our NSS students conducted interactive sessions with the AshramShala students. These sessions included motivational talks, storytelling, and small educational activities to inspire and encourage these young minds. The celebration of Teacher's Day Month at Goji Village was a resounding success. The AshramShala students were

overjoyed to receive stationery kits, and their enthusiasm for learning was evident. The NSS students of the BBA, B. Com, and MBA programs at our institution are committed to making a meaningful impact on society. This event not only celebrated the spirit of teaching but also emphasized the importance of education for underprivileged children.
