Best Oral Presentation

National conference on “New Imperatives in Drug Design and Discovery” (NIDDD-2019) was organized and hosted by Department of Chemistry, Uka Tarsadia University, Surat (Gujarat-India) during 22nd-23rd November – 2019. This conference was organized in association with Indian Society of Chemists and Biologists (ISCB) Lucknow, India and The National Academy of Sciences, India (Mumbai Chapter).

The major aim of this conference was to provide opportunity to young researchers and students to interact with eminent speakers and also present their work in the form of posters and oral communications. The scientific sessions included several plenary lectures, oral communications and poster presentations from various subject areas of Chemical Sciences, Pharmaceutical sciences and Biological sciences.

Dr. Rajamouli Boddula and **Dr. Satyanarayan Battula** from Department of Chemistry have received Best Oral Presentation awards.

Dr. B. Rajamouli has delivered a presentation on topic “*Strategic Design of Tunable Light Emissive Eu(III) Complexes for LEDs/OLEDs*”. He is mainly focused on the luminescent materials for optoelectronic materials and photodynamic therapy.

Satyanarayan Battula has delivered a presentation on topic “*The structural unit (cohnIn2) assisted synthesis to valuable functionalized heterocycles*”. He has explained regards heterocycles functionalization through structural unit assistance.

Total of 350 delegates across the country were registered for NIDDD-2019. Total 14 abstracts were accepted for oral presentations and 68 abstracts were accepted for poster presentations by scientific committee.

The NIDDD-2019 was financially supported by GUJCOST, DST and GSBTM (Government of Gujarat) funding agencies.
