

## Report

**Department of Chemistry, Uka Tarsadia University, Surat (Gujarat-India) and Indian Council of Chemists (ICC - Agra) organized 34<sup>th</sup> Annual National Conference of ICC during 26<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> December– 2015.**

The conference assembled the eminent scientists and young researchers from the academia, research institution and industry from all across the world for Three days, 26<sup>th</sup> - 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2015. The leading researchers and key opinion leaders in Chemistry have been invited to facilitate sessions and deliver lectures at 34<sup>th</sup> Annual National Conference of ICC. A series of scientific and educational activities have also been planned for delegates participated during the conference. There will be vast range of learning opportunities at invited talks, oral, poster presentations and symposium session. Beside the inaugural lecture, 5 plenary and more than 40 invited lectures of highly diverse scientific disciplines were delivered at the different sessions of conference. Total five sessions were held over Three days comprising the broad topics in the Inorganic chemistry section, Organic chemistry section, Physical Chemistry section, Analytical and Environmental Chemistry section, Pharmaceutical & Bio Chemistry Section. Conference brought together leading Chemists, medicinal chemists, pharmacologists, biotechnologists, and other allied professionals under one roof to discuss and present the latest important developments in drug discovery and therapeutics.
