General Guidelines:

- A student is permitted to participate in a maximum of three events of 10th UTh Fest.
- Each institute/department can send entries strictly as per the event-wise participation limits mentioned in the official event at a glance table.



3. Only bonafide, full-time students enrolled in Diploma, Undergraduate, or Postgraduate programmes of the constituent institutes/departments of Uka Tarsadia University are eligible to participate.
4. Participants must carry their original University Identity Card during the Uth Fest.
5. Students from each participating institute/department must be accompanied by their respective Institute Team Leader.
6. Participants have to follow time limits for all events wherever applicable.
7. On-the-spot registrations are not permitted for any event.
8. If the behaviour of any participant is found to be contrary to the objectives of the festival, Uka Tarsadia University reserves the right to take appropriate action, including disqualification from the 10th Uth Fest.
9. Eve teasing, influencing adjudicators, indecent behaviour, or any form of misconduct within the campus or event venues is strictly prohibited. Violators will be subject to disciplinary action, which may include disqualification from the festival.
- 10. To encourage creativity, Institute Team Leaders are requested to present new items and avoid repeating performances presented in the previous year.**
11. Participants are advised to carefully read and understand the detailed rules and regulations of each event available on the official website www.utu.ac.in/uthfest.
- 12. Participants and Team Leaders are not allowed to approach the judges before or after any event. For event-related queries or feedback, they may contact the Fest In-Charge Committee after the completion of the fest.**
- 13. The decision of the judges appointed for various events shall be final and binding. It is expected that their judgment will be respected. No protests or appeals regarding judgments will be entertained.**
